About this Course

Successful completion of this course results in nationally recognised Unit of Competency PUAFER008 - Confine Small Emergencies in a Facility.

This unit of competency involves the skills and knowledge required to confine small emergencies in a facility and it applies to occupants who are required to have first attack firefighting skills. It includes preparing for emergency situations, identifying and assessing an emergency, safely confining emergencies, using initial response equipment and reporting on the facility's emergency response.

Small emergencies in a facility include incidents such as small fires that can be controlled using a fire extinguisher; chemical spills that can be controlled using facility personal protective clothing and equipment and a spill kit; or a vehicle accident where there is no significant injury or damage.



What is covered in the course?

You will gain the following knowledge:

- Preparing for emergency situations
- Identifying and assessing emergency
- Safely confining emergencies
- Using initial response equipment

People who need this Unit of Competency include:

- People attending a facility on a permanent or temporary basis such as an employee, contractor, student or resident, who may be required to confine small emergencies in that facility.
- People who wish to undertake emergency response training

You will only be admitted if you meet the following prerequisites:

- Can ask questions to clarify instructions
- Are able to listen to instructions to identify key safety information

Once you have enrolled into this course then you will receive a user name and login details. These details will be used to access your course which includes:

- 1. Learning presentations
- 2. Multiple choice and written questions
- 3. A practical assessment

This is a face to face course. To complete this course face to face, particpants will need to undertake the following:
